

I think there are lots of reasons ^{some} 1 & 2 are:

- 1) culture - Pervasiveness of violence across culture -
- 2) neoliberalism - profit before everything. War + violence = £. A non-violent society isn't in the interest of those with economic power & this means society in general is violent - we can't expect to live in perpetual war & eliminate other forms of violence.
- 3) male-controlled state - even where laws prohibit violence against women, they are not enforced by male controlled state structures like the 'justice' system. This circles back to culture - how can we expect justice in a culture where women are perpetually dehumanised & blamed?
